EARTH DAY, 2021

1. **Date:** 21ST APRIL, 2021 (22nd April was holiday for the Assembly Election in the area).

2. **Organised By:** Nature Club and IQAC.

3. **Venue:** Due to suspension of regular academic activity by the Government for the outbreak of Covid pandemic, the event was held online via Google Meet Platform.

4. **Level of the Activity:** College Level.

5. **Objective of the event:** The Earth Day is observed worldwide on 22nd April to raise awareness and create sensitivity to protect our mother Earth and restore the world's ecosystem. Every year the quality of air, water and soil, the basic and necessary condition to sustain life on earth is being deteriorated. And sometimes the deterioration is irreversible.
