REPORT ON INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2023-2024

Department of Commerce

The College conducts Induction Programme every year since 2020. The Department of Commerce like every year held its Induction Programme with the new Semester 1 in August 2023. The Department conducted the Programme for five days individually and one day as Library Induction programme, and another day as Value oriented Induction programme in the Yoga and Meditation department.

08.08.2023 Programme :1

The Department of Commerce conducted a programme where the new Semester 1 introduced themselves and they talked about their own interests and talents. They were also inquisitive about different activities and different methodologies used in the courses. All the three teachers joined students in breaking the ice and thus made a very friendly introductory event for Semester 1. This was the first session of the Induction programme.



09.08.2023 Programme 2:

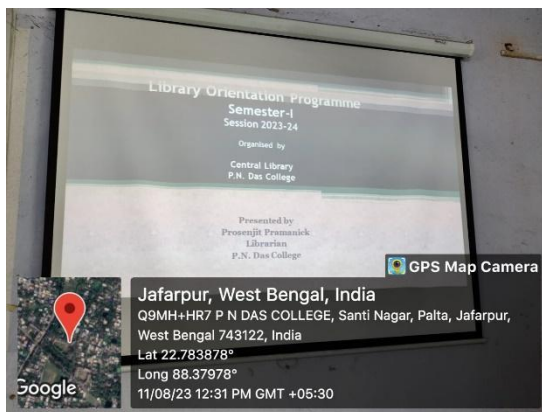
11.08.2023 Programme 5 :
